Meet Your Teacher

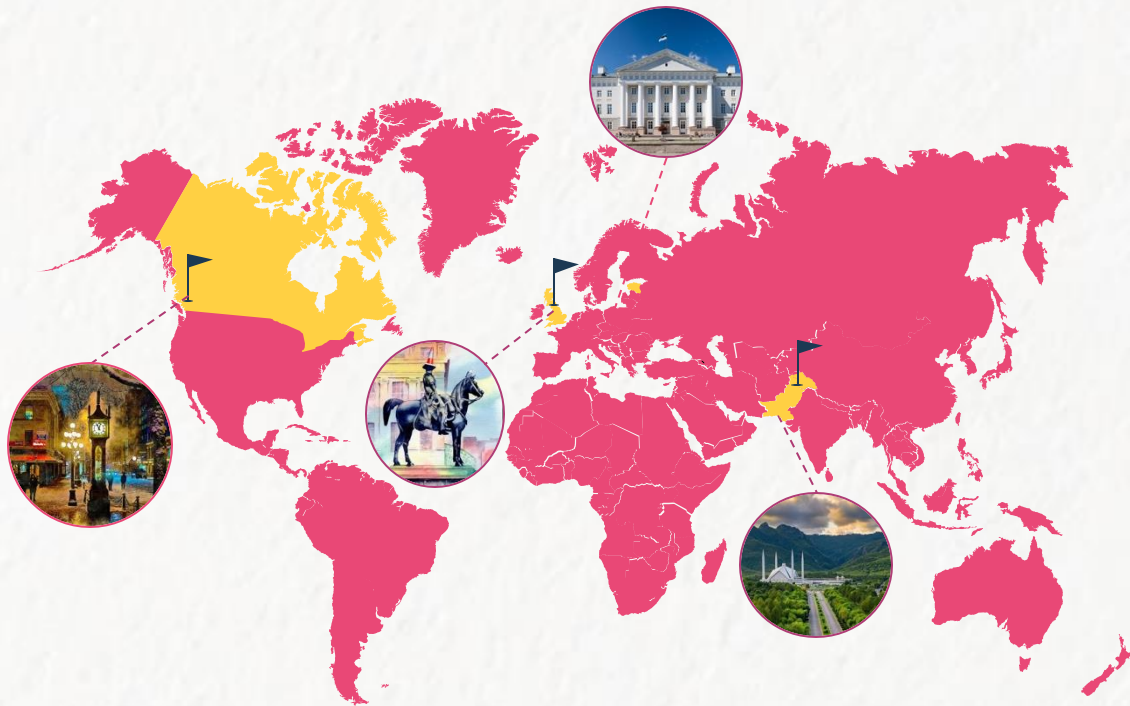
Assalamoalaikum. Marhaba.

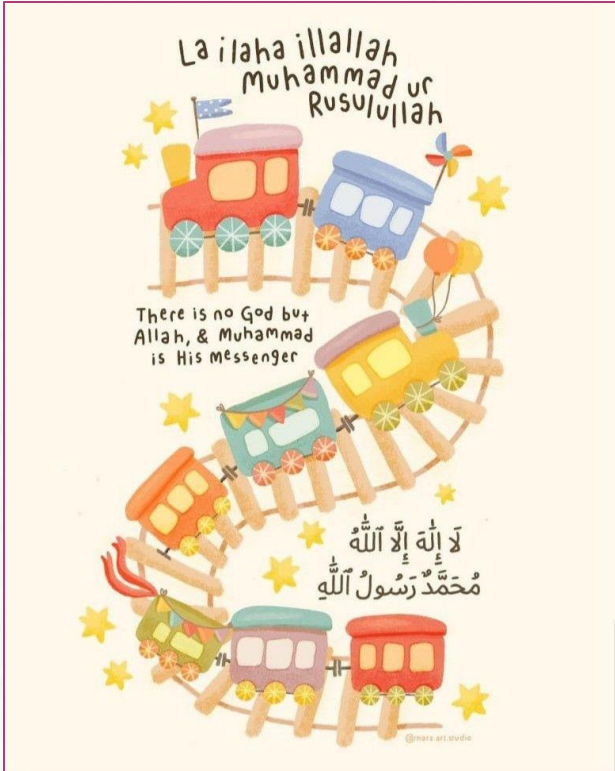
A Little about Kalima



Let's have a little chat about Allah — just share what you know, and we'll learn together insha'Allah.


- Who is Allah?

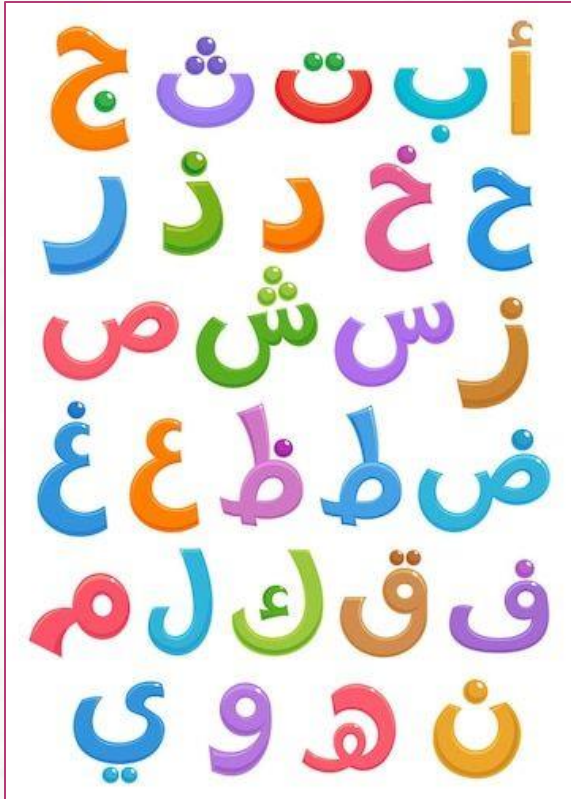

Learning Objectives

ARABIC FOR QURAN

- Short and Long Vowels (pronunciation rules , elongation, merging, skipping)
- Quran Recitation: Surah An-Nas, Al-Falaq, Al-Ikhlās, Al-Masad, An-Nasr, Al-Kāfirūn, Al-Fatīhah

ISLAMIC KNOWLEDGE

- Kalima-e-Tayyab, Kalima-e-Shahada, Wudu, Salat
- 6 of Allah's names (Allah, Ar-Rahman, Ar-Raheem, Al-Ahad, As-Samad, Al-Malik)
- Arch Angels: Jibrail (AS), Mikail (AS), Israfil (AS), Izrail (AS)
- Quran and previous books
- Prophet's Stories: Adam (AS), Ibrahim (AS), Daud (AS), Musa (AS), Isa (AS), Mohammad (SAW)
- 6 short du'as, 6 short ahadith

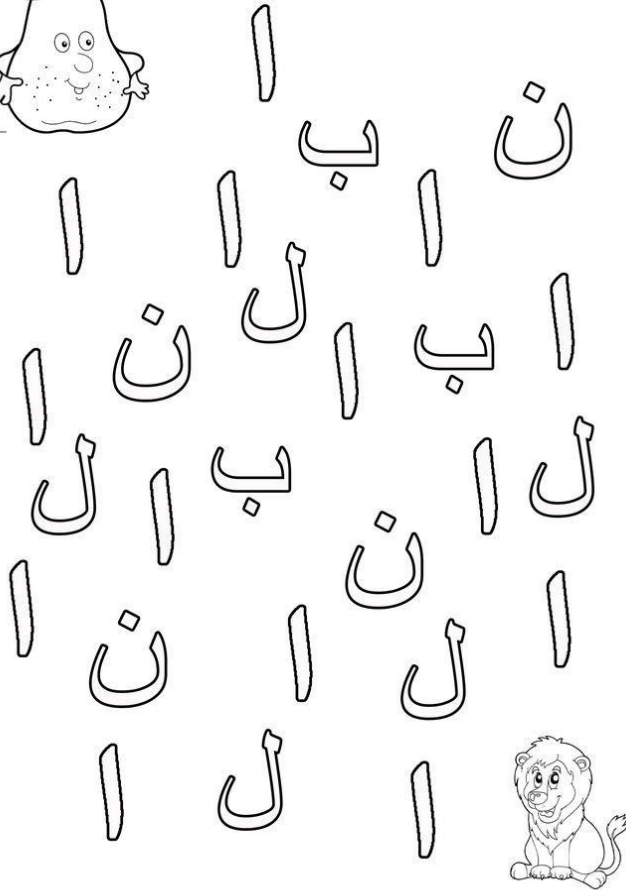
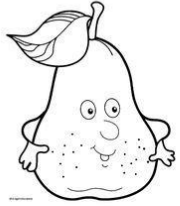

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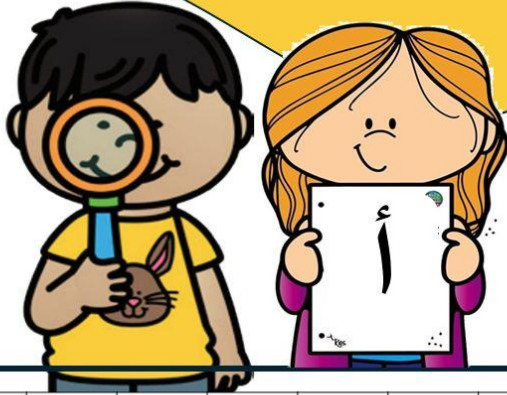
